The South Milwaukee Lions Club will award one-time \$2,000 scholarships to 1 to 2 students: from South Milwaukee High School, or to any eligible South Milwaukee resident, or child/grandchild/legal guardian of a South Milwaukee Lions Club member, and/or a South Milwaukee Lions Club Leo graduating from High School in 2019 or 2020. Scholarships are to cover school expenses for students attending any post-secondary school. Students are eligible for two years following High School graduation.

Since 1955, the South Milwaukee Lions have awarded scholarships to students attending a post-secondary school to continue their education. "We Serve" is the Lion's International motto. Brad Knoche was a teacher and coach for the South Milwaukee School District and a South Milwaukee Lion. In both capacities, he was a leader in service to others and our community. It is in recognition of Brad's service to South Milwaukee that our Lion's Scholarships are given to deserving students that believe in giving back to our community.
